**Title:** Special Transportation – Program Eligibility and Operating Procedures  
**Date:** November 26, 2018

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**That** Council accept the administration's recommendations to better manage participant eligibility for the special transportation program municipal grant and to better control the fluctuation of costs incurred by the program in order to meet the annual budget.

Consequently, Council agrees that the administration:

1. establish eligibility categories (complete, conditional and temporary);
2. add financial capability to eligibility criteria;
3. create an evaluation committee comprised of individuals with knowledge and expertise to evaluate eligibility requests;
4. perform, when required, customer evaluation through third parties specialized in various fields;
5. establish a maximum number of customers eligible for service at a ratio of 65% of customers with wheelchair and 35% of customers without wheelchair;
6. limit the number of subsidized trips per person based on the needs analysis;
7. establish and maintain a waiting list for customers who wish to use the service (a list of customers with wheelchair and another list without wheelchair);
8. prioritize customers on waiting list based on the needs analysis;
9. proceed with the reassessment of all customers who are currently eligible for service;
10. increase the fare per ride within Dieppe to \$3 (public transit will be set at \$2.75 from January 1st, 2019) and outside city limits to \$6 (currently set at \$5);
11. implement the new measures on January 1st, 2019;
12. explore the implementation of a volunteer drivers program for customers without wheelchair.
