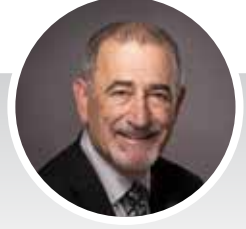

Municipal services

The City of Dieppe will provide many municipal services to you starting on January 1, 2023. However, certain services like garbage collection and snow removal will remain the responsibility of the province or of private companies hired by the New Brunswick government.

Over time, the City of Dieppe will take over more and more services in your area.

New Brunswick municipalities establish bylaws and policies for the wellbeing of the community. With respect to enforcement of the City of Dieppe's bylaws and policies, the province is working on determining the best way to proceed during the transition. For now, bylaws currently in effect in your area will remain enforceable. We will inform you of any updates.

Budgets and finances

The mission of the City of Dieppe is to offer high-quality services to residents will making responsible decisions for the common good.

We've worked carefully to set a tax rate that best reflects the level of services that will be provided to you in 2023.



Tax rate	LSD
\$ 0,5445 per \$100 of assessment	Greater Lakeburn
\$ 0,4677 per \$100 of assessment	Scoudouc

Note that this rate may change in 2024 and that you will still have a rate to pay directly to the province for the services that it will still be providing to you.

You can register yourself or your child online for the various activities offered by the City of Dieppe. You just need to get a profile number by filling out a form available at dieppe.ca/registration, at the Aquatic and Sports Centre or at City Hall at least 24 business hours before the registration date.

Important: if you already have a profile number, you must provide us with proof of your address before the registration day for swimming lessons. You can send us a copy of a recent invoice or your driver's licence by email or present it to us in person at the Aquatic and Sports Centre or at City Hall. Note that the transfer from a non-resident profile to a resident profile will not be done automatically. Proof of residency is required.
